Each key is represented by a four cell column in the table. Each column represents the following combinations

1. Primary key
 2. Shift + Primary key
 3. AltGr + Primary key
 4. AltGr + Shift + Primary key

Notes:

1. Where a letter with an accent appears it comes from the key combination followed by the letter.
 2. Not all accents are available on all letters. With accented letters, all the available ones are shown,
 3. Press AltGr and then Shift (while still holding down AltGr) and then the primary key (while still holding down the other two) to get the combination.
 4. The combinations labelled “???” don't seem to do anything, either on their own or preceding another character to accent it.
 5. Font used: Bitstream Vera Serif, 12pt.
 6. OO.o version: Build 2.0.0.1, Novell edition.
 7. Most of these key combinations are available from xterm too.
